

September 4, 1978 Darśana with Baba Hari Dass at a Retreat

Edit notes: The following was typed from notes handwritten at the time of the darśana. Q denotes a question. B indicates what Babaji wrote on his chalkboard, as read by the reader, and then as heard and noted by someone present. R is comments likely of the chalkboard reader. Comments in square brackets are generally those of the typist. There was editing for format and IAST transliteration of Sanskrit terms.

B: The Mahābhārata was a world war.

Q: Did Kriṣṇa really fight in it?

B: Yes. Dvāpara yuga...

R: ... the time of the Mahābhārata

B: ... was much before the [time of the] Bible.

B: Deva varṣa: 1 day = 100 of our years.

Q: The Bible says the same. This was in dvāpara yuga?

B: Star of David, five-pointed star, Christian cross, trident, and svastika [all drawn in a row by Babaji, not written] are all the same.

Q: Jews are overrepresented in all new age spiritual groups in the West perhaps, Shlomo Carlebach says, because so many leaders and adepts of Jewish mysticism died off during WWII.

B: Priests of all religions are the same.

Q: Pyramids of Egypt....

B: The same as in sahasrāra. Up and down energies.

Q: All domed buildings?

B: Yes.
